Letter from ROOSEVELT The People's Mayor of Atlanta

Since the age of 14 I have owned a business and was forced to stand on my own two feet. After being turned down at every avenue by family and friends, I was determined to continue my path alone in order to reach success. I realized a short time later that it is almost impossible to achieve real change and great success alone.

That brings me to the point of this letter, **I need your help to Make Atlanta Safe Again.** We have gone too long without a unified city government. Over the past few years I have watched several officials speak bad about each other, throw the other under the bus and even publicly blame the Mayor for certain issues.
