## **Response from ROOSEVELT The People's Mayor of Atlanta**

I would like to first thank **The Buckhead Coalition** for the opportunity to address some of the major concerns we are facing as a city. The path we are currently on is leading us backwards and city hall, for decades, has been draining the pockets of loyal tax paying residents such as yourself.

Here are the official responses to questions from **The People of Buckhead**.

Question 1: What will you commit to do to respond to the prevalence of youth water sales?

**We are a city of resources. Yet we are failing to provide them to the ones who need them the most. We will open the first Entrepreneurship Night School. Giving youth entrepreneurs the chance to learn the right way to conduct business. No longer will they be allowed to terrorize the streets. Parents will be held accountable for teens under 17. Those over 18 will be cited with citations ranging from \$50-100 per occurrence. We will also be building 6 new community centers aimed at providing evening/day classes and events to the youth.**

Question 2: What will you commit to do to respond to clubs that abuse conditions of their liquor licenses? (Limit response to 100 words.)

**The clubs in Atlanta are getting out of hand and I can say that because I have witnessed first hand just how crazy it can get at these places. We have to be more accountable as a whole. My administration will create a division within the Police department called "The People's Patrol." Hiring 1,000+ residents consisting of veterans, ex police, social workers and certified citizens, tasked with the mission of responding to non-emergency calls such as noise complaints. We will introduce legislation enforcing citations and fines for businesses that abuse their licenses. This task force will operate between 1AM-7AM.**

Question 3: What will you commit to do to respond to street racing? (Limit response to 100 words.)

**Step 11 of my 100 day Path to #ReclaimAtlanta is to begin fixing all public roads by 2024. In addition, APD's Crime suppression unit coupled with The People's Patrol will be required to enforce road safety. Patrol units will be used to surveil, report and issue noise citations. APD's unit will work closely with GSP to monitor well known areas of road racers and we will utilize modern day technology to apprehend violators. The relationship between Buckhead and City Hall is so broken that many in Buckhead have seemingly given up hope and decided to try forming their own city.

Question 4: What will you commit to do to restore confidence in Atlanta city government among Buckhead residents and businesses? (Limit response to [200](#) words.)

**My mom always told me, "what's done in the dark eventually comes to light". I didn't really understand but now as an adult it is very clear.**

**I believe the ideal leader is one who has integrity, morals, and holds everyone accountable including themselves. Part of my 100 Day plan is to audit and investigate each department and require a financial report within 5 weeks of inauguration. We will not stop until the swamp is cleansed and every fraud politician is wiped from city hall. My team has already uncovered millions of dollars in potentially fraudulent transactions and we are concerned.**

**The People's administration will commit to transparency and allow residents a true chance at having their voices heard. The residents of BuckHead want to annex from the city however I am asking for them to think about the NOW. I support the annexation being on the ballot because I believe we live in a Free Country and the people should choose who governs their daily lives. In the same context, I would like the citizens of BuckHead to think about the present day. Look at the candidates we have on this year's ballot.**

**All 5 front runners have collectively done over 40 years of work for the city. Unfortunately not all of them have had Atlanta in their best interest. 2 of which are currently under Federal Investigation. The others may be committed and have the funding, but they are lacking the passion for CHANGE! We need a fresh start and I am here to bring it! The Buckhead Coalition has adopted homelessness one area of focus of our outreach.

Question 5: What will you commit to do to address homelessness? (Limit response to 100 words.)

**I know you've seen the Snicker commercial.. Hunger leads to Anger. Anger leads to theft and theft eventually leads to violent crime. The homeless population consist of laborers, disable, mentally ill and many who are just down on bad luck. If you make \$1,200 a month. Any apartment or home that you move in plus 2.5-3.0x the rent, references, bank statements, rental history and good credit. This halves your tenant base and decreases the amount of homes available for many residents. We will build city owned affordable homes. Making them available as soon as Summer 2022 using modular building technology.**

Many in Buckhead believe that the current proposal to rezone Atlanta threatens the stable single family neighborhoods that make up most of Buckhead, and that even define the community.

Question 6: What role do you envision for Buckhead to play to address our City's housing challenges? (Limit response to 100 words.)
